I. What is the Gospel?

- A. The Gospel is the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. **1 Corinthians 15:1-4**
- B. The Gospel is the power of God unto salvation. **Romans 1:16**

II. We are crucified with Christ. **Galatians 2:20**

(The old sinful nature must be surrendered.)

III. We are buried with Christ. **Romans 6:3&4**

IV. We are resurrected with Christ. **Romans 6:5**
